

ADDENDUM TO RESOLUTION 2026-002

**A RESOLUTION UNDER THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF FANNING SPRINGS,
FLORIDA AMENDING RESOLUTION 2026-002 TO INCLUDE AN ADDITIONAL
VACANT COUNCIL SEAT**

WHEREAS, on June 2, 2026, the City Council of Fanning Springs adopted Resolution 2026-002 calling for a Non-Partisan election to be held on November 3, 2026 (with a primary election on October 6, 2026, if required) for Council Seats #3 and #4 and for the office of Mayor; and,

WHEREAS, an additional vacancy now exists for Council Seat #5; and,

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Fanning Springs, Florida requires the filling of all vacant Council seats through the Non-Partisan election process; and,

WHEREAS, all other provisions of Resolution 2026-002, including qualifying procedures, fees, registration book closing dates, and election dates, remain in full force and effect and shall apply equally to the newly added Council Seat #5;

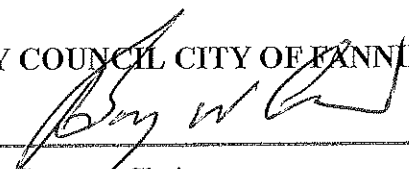
NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Fanning Springs, Florida, that Resolution 2026-002 is hereby amended as follows:

1. All references to the seats up for election are amended to include Council Seat #5.
2. In the third WHEREAS clause of Resolution 2026-002, the phrase “for seats number Three (3), or seat number Four (4)” is replaced with “for seats number Three (3), Four (4), or Five (5)”.
3. In the NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED clause of Resolution 2026-002, the phrase “for Council Seats #3, Seat #4, and Mayor” is replaced with “for Council Seats #3, #4, #5, and Mayor”.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the required notices of this Addendum shall be published and a copy of this Addendum shall be furnished to the Supervisor of Elections of Gilchrist and Levy Counties, along with the original Resolution 2026-002.

RESOLUTION 2026-002

A RESOLUTION UNDER THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF FANNING SPRINGS, FLORIDA PROVIDING FOR A NON-PARTISAN ELECTION

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Fanning Springs, Florida requires the providing for a Non-Partisan election to be held **November 3, 2026** and for a primary election on **October 6, 2026**, if one is required, under Article V Section 5.4 of said Charter depending on whether or not more than two candidates seek the same office, and,

WHEREAS, section 97.055 Florida Statutes require the closing of the registration books 29 days prior to said election. Therefore, if a primary is required on **October 6, 2026** the registration books will close **September 7, 2026**. Registration books will close for the **November 3, 2026**, election on **October 5, 2026** until 7:00 pm on **November 3, 2026** and,

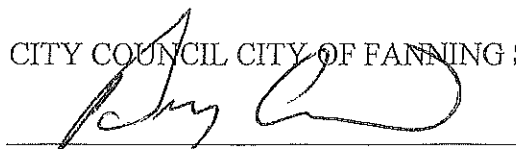
WHEREAS, any citizen qualified as required by Article III Section 3.02 (elector) may become a candidate for Council Member for seats number Three (3), or seat number Four (4), by paying the qualifying fee of Two Hundred dollars (\$200.00) including the State of Florida Assessment of one percent of the annual salary for Council seats or qualifying fee for Mayor of One Thousand dollars (\$1000.00) including the State of Florida Assessment of one percent of the annual salary, filling the Oath of Office and completing other forms required, with the City Clerk, at the Fanning Springs City Hall, during office hours beginning at 9:00 am on **August 24, 2026** ending **August 27, 2026** at 12:00 pm Noon.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that a Non-Partisan election for Council Seats #3, Seat #4, and Mayor is hereby called for **November 3, 2026** the primary thereof, if required, for **October 6, 2026**.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED, that the required notices be published and a copy of this resolution be furnished to the Supervisor of Elections of Gilchrist and Levy Counties.
